Undergraduate Courses

History and Theory 7: Theories and policies for the contemporary city

The course attempts to highlight the changes that have taken place during the last decades and that characterize both the cities and the perceptions about them. Its objective is to bring the students in contact with new methodological instruments in order to assist them in understanding these transformations and the complex relationship of Urbanism in Greece with the theories and practices which are formed in the international arena. In this context, the course provides insights on issues related to the theory of urban planning and urban design through interdisciplinary approaches that link the architectural and urban readings with readings of history, social science and human geography. The issues examined are included in the scientific field of urban studies.

Special Topics in Gender and Space 8: Identity, Diversity and Space

The course attempts an introduction to theories of gender and space, intending to unveil ambiguities and difference in the constitution of these concepts. It aims to problematise the ways in which gender identities permeate the organization, design and production of space and at the same time bring to the fore the gendered character of many dominant hypotheses about space and design, at scales relating to urban space and to the multiplicity of everyday life.

Architectural Design 8A: Outdoor public Architecture in physical and urban landscape

Methodology approaches of investigation and design of outdoor public space as part of the immediate urban and natural setting where it is embedded. Concepts of landscape architecture and correlation with the process of architectural and urban design.
